Suedwolle weaving yarn collection for Spring/Summer 2027

Inspired by lightness, movement, and forward-thinking technologies

Nuremberg – September 2025 – Suedwolle Group presents its Spring/Summer 2027 weaving yarn collection *Solar Drift* and *SWLab*, uniting seasonal inspiration with experimental yarn development. Celebrating refined natural fibres, advanced spinning technologies, and versatile design, the collection draws on the energy of light and movement to create yarns for fabrics that are comfortable, breathable, and built to last.

Solar Drift: Summer in every strand

At the core of *Solar Drift* is the blending of Merino wool's exceptional properties with other fibres – each composition chosen for its ability to stay cool and comfortable in all weather conditions. Wool-linen blends such as *Peschici* Nm 42/1 (51% Wool 18,4 µ, 23% Silk, 26% Linen) combine durability, absorbency, and breathability with Merino's natural comfort.

With long-standing expertise in mohair fibre processing, Suedwolle Group spins it pure and in blends, resulting in high-end wool-mohair yarns, like *Oropa RMS* Nm 32/1 (83% Super Kid Cape Mohair RMS certified, 17% Linen Super). These blends offer resilience, comfort, freshness, and durability.

Suedwolle Group's advanced spinning technology *Betaspun*® is known for delivering strength, abrasion resistance, good pilling performance and a clean surface. For this collection, the company developed a 100% bio-based *Betaspun*® yarn named *Fedaia Betaspun*® Nm 68/1 (61,4% Wool 17.5 µ TEC, 38,6% Cotton NE 100), made by wrapping a fine cotton yarn around a Merino core.

This collection gives designers yarns that balance comfort and performance, with options ranging from lightweight summer tailoring to technical outerwear. By combining natural fibres with modern spinning techniques, it opens new possibilities for wool in the spring and summer season.

Inspiration for the seasons ahead

The launch is accompanied by the latest edition of *The Wool Chronicle*, Suedwolle Group's seasonal publication for designers and industry partners, offering deeper insight into the collection's inspirations, techniques, and applications.

SWLab, a special selection of yarns in development, pushes the boundaries of Merino wool blend yarns through visionary experimentation and the expansion of weaving possibilities.
