This selection includes yarns such as *Amiata* Nm 16/2 S 220 (100% Alpaca Suri) for bright and warm pile fabrics, and *Candelo RMS RWS* Nm 40/1 / Nm 40/2 / Nm 40/3 (50% Wool 19.3 µ RWS, 40% Super Kid Cape Mohair RMS, 10% Cashmere) for elegant fabrics with a bright and fluid drape. A unique offer that reflects the company's longstanding expertise in premium fibre spinning.

Utility: Wool for contemporary wear

The *Utility* theme draws inspiration from everyday clothing and translates it into a curated collection of wool-blended yarns, carefully engineered for pieces made to be lived with. *Banda TEC* Nm 37/2 / Nm 37/3 X-COMPACT® (100% Wool 17.2 µ TEC) - the ultimate protagonist of our upcoming Innovation Hub story - brings a refined wool-based interpretation to denim fabrics, allowing multiple weights and applications.

Following this direction, *Mayon* Nm 36/2 S 480 (40% Wool 20.3 µ TEC, 60% LENZING™ Lyocell) delivers a cooler and more fluid touch by blending wool with lyocell. Thought for everyday use, *Utility* offers yarns that are versatile and ideal also for shirts and jackets. The quality yarn *Shirtwool* Nm 60/1 X-COMPACT® (100% Wool 17.2 µ TEC) is the perfect choice for a refined look with a soft handfeel.

Essence: Meaningful balance

The *Essence* capsule balances classic designs and current trends and explores the versatility of wool yarns using advanced spinning solutions. *BigRock Betaspun®* RWS Nm 60/1 (87.4% Wool 18.4 µ TEC, 12.6% Polyamide Filament GRS Black) plays with the rhythm of colours and surfaces in a reinterpretation of traditional jaspé, in which wool spun with a black polyamide filament for structure, abrasion resistance and colour effect. *Nativo GOTS* Nm 2.000 (75% Wool 19,5 µ GOTS 25% Alpaca) introduces a fancy yarn with a rich and expressive wool-alpaca blend for a soft hand feel and authentic look.

Seasonal yarn highlights

The highlights section showcases blends selected for their brilliance, lightness, and character.

M148 RMS Nm 22.6/1 X-COMPACT® (100% Kid Cape Mohair RMS) delivers a clear, luminous mohair character. Among the new introductions, *Courchevel* RMS SFA Nm 40.5/1 X-COMPACT® (90% Super Kid Cape Mohair RMS, 10% Cashmere SFA) brings a soft, elevated luxury touch, while *Chamois* RMS Nm 22.6/1 X-COMPACT® (80% Kid Mohair RMS, 20% Mulberry Silk) offers a bright look with smoother handfeel. The theme is rounded off by *Crespini* for surf aces with a crisp character. *CRS Tonale* Nm 100/2 (84% Wool 19.3 µ, 16% Silk Filament) combines natural components to create a yarn that unites lightness, strength, and elegance.

SWLab: A look into tomorrow's yarn ideas

Suedwolle Group continues with its research project SWLab, a dedicated space for showcasing the most exploratory stages of yarn development within Suedwolle Group's weaving segment.
